Accreditation

In 1959, Woodstock was the first school in Asia to be accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. For more than 50 years, Woodstock students have received a diploma which enables them to enter colleges and universities in the US and elsewhere. In 2007, Woodstock was again the first in Asia to be awarded the MSA's new International Credential, a mark that our programme meets stringent criteria for a global style and quality of education. The school also holds accreditation with the Commission on International and Trans-regional Accreditation.

Woodstock is a member of the European Council of International Schools, the Near East and South Asia Council of International Schools and the National Association of Independent Schools (US).

External Examinations

Woodstock is an approved testing centre for the following exams:

PSAT Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test: given to all Grade 11 students in October.

PLAN Preliminary American College Test: given to all Grade 10 students in November.

SAT I Scholastic Assessment Test: required by many US colleges as part of the admissions procedure.

SAT II Scholastic Assessment Test: required by some US colleges as part of the admissions procedure.

ACT American College Test: required by many US colleges as part of the admissions procedure.

IGCSE: Woodstock's curriculum maintains a strong link between the content of appropriate Grade 9 and 10 courses and published syllabi for the International GCSE. The IGCSE exams may be taken at the end of Grade 10.

Advanced Placement (AP): AP exams are college-level examinations used by many U.S. colleges for granting college credit and/or waiving courses in the US. APs are used increasingly in other countries as part of the admissions process.
