## **Residential Life**

Residence life is an integral part of the Woodstock experience. Woodstock is a small school where everyone knows everyone else, creating a friendly and supportive atmosphere in which there is room for each student to make a unique contribution to community life. Students are considered for boarding from age eight onwards, and live in the school's six residences in various parts of the campus according to age and sex.

The school's residence staff, the 'Dorm Parents', are professional and experienced teachers and counselors who coordinate students' extracurricular and weekend activities to complement and enhance the academic programme. Living in a diverse community, students learn about their own cultures as well as the values and perspectives of others through interactions with peers and staff from around the world.

The residences in Woodstock are: Edgehill (Elementary Boys and Girls), Community Centre, Ridgewood (Middle & High School Boys), Alter Ridge (Middle School Girls), Midlands (High School Girls), and Hostel (High School Boys).
